Beginning **Monday, March 16** free breakfast and lunch will be given to *any* child ages 1-18 years at *every* school site. Students do not need to qualify for free or reduced lunch to receive a meal. Meals will be available for pick up at each school from 8:30-9:30 a.m. and 11:00-12:30 p.m. every weekday. Any student will be served at any school even if not enrolled in that school or in the Auburn School District.

Meals are to be taken home, students will not be able to eat at the school site. The district can provide one breakfast and one lunch per child per day. Students can receive a breakfast and a lunch meal at the same time, but only one of each per day. If lunch is picked up during breakfast time, it will be a cold meal.
